

Organization Categories and Organization Types

Overview

[Organization Categories](#) allow campus administrators the ability to classify organizations into similar groupings. These categories serve multiple functions. First, these categories allow users to sort through the full organization directory by category. Categories may also be created for administrative use only, giving you an internal system for marking organizations according to your campus's practices or policies. Lastly, you can also use the messaging tool to communicate with users in specific organization categories.

[Organization Types](#) allow you to classify your organizations based on how you want them to behave. Additionally, organization types allow for more administrative control, including the ability to add restrictions to tools, assign specific position templates, or customize the re-registration process.

Below you will find some examples of common Organization Categories and Organization Types that campuses use. These examples are not meant to be exhaustive but will help give you some ideas of ways that you might want to set up Organization Categories and Organization Types.
